

2017 CAMPER AGREEMENT

At atmosphere of acceptance and caring pervades this Christian camp program. Counselors and campers plan, work, play, worship, and grow together as they strive to build a community of trust, openness, sharing, respect and forgiveness. Campers are challenged to grow physically, emotionally, and socially, and to deepen their faith in Jesus Christ. - find mature and peaceful ways to solve problems and disagreements (physical and verbal aggression is not tolerated)
- seek the good and positive in everything I do
- ENJOY MY TIME AT CAMP AND HAVE ALL THE FUN I POSSIBLY CAN!
