


Cedarkirk requires that all registered campers either:

 Upload a copy of their COVID vaccinations card showing full vaccination status

OR

 Present evidence of a negative PCR test taken no more than 5 days from the start of the camp session

Option 1

Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination:

Vaccinated participants must upload a picture of their CDC-issued vaccine card to their Cedarkirk registration account.

Proof of COVID-19 vaccination must include:

- Personal identifiers (full name and date of birth);
- Name of the official source issuing the vaccine (e.g. public health agency, doctor's office, or other authorized vaccine provider);
- Vaccine manufacturer and date(s) of vaccination.

Option 2

Proof of Negative PCR Test

Participants who do not show proof of vaccination will be required to show proof of a negative PCR test administered within 5 days of arrival. Campers must be tested at a site that is supervised by qualified health care providers.

The following components must be included in your proof of a negative test:

- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Date of test
- Test provider
- Test result- The result can be shown as a printed copy or digital health record (e.g., web page, email, or text message from a test provider or laboratory).

How to upload vaccination card or proof of negative COVID test into your account

Either the Covid-19 Vaccination card or the Proof of Negative PCR Test will need to be uploaded to your campers CampBrain account

1. Go to: cedarkirk.campbrainregistration.com
2. Login to your account
3. Under "View My Submitted Applications" click on the green button labeled "view details" under your campers name
4. Under the Upload document section click the green "upload" button under covid-19 vaccination card.
